Please note the following revisions to the influenza vaccine pages of the Communicable Disease Control Manual Chapter II – Immunization Program:

Page 31 Influenza Vaccine (Inactivated Split-Virion):

- Vaxigrip® is the influenza vaccine to be offered to children aged 6 to 23 months
- New proviso in bullet #3 under "People capable of transmitting influenza
 to those at elevated risk for complications of disease:" Household
 contacts of children aged 0 to 23 months are eligible for influenza vaccine
 when these children either cannot be vaccinated or may respond
 inadequately to vaccination.

Page 32a Influenza Vaccine (Inactivated Split-Virion) (Vaxigrip®):
