The changes from the 2012 BC FIORP to 2024 BC FIORP are summarized below:


This revision of the BC FIORP includes a major restructure of the contents to improve the flow and readability of the document based on protocols from Canada, Ontario, Quebec and Alberta. It has also been modernized by updating language to account for changes in technology and practices.

Noteworthy changes to the BC FIORP include:

- Addition of section 5.6 Incorporate a One Health approach
- Addition of section 5.7 Commitment to cultural safety
- Addition of section 7.10.2 Information exchange with Indigenous communities
- Revision of the Roles and Responsibilities of Partners (Annex C)
 - Updates to existing Partner roles and responsibilities and addition of the BC Ministry of Water, Land and Resource Stewardship (C.2.6) and the First Nations Health Authority (C.2.7) as partners.
- Addition of the Public Health and Animal Health Partners Collaborative Investigation Protocol (Annex B)
- Revision of the BC FIORP Meeting Agenda Template (Annex E)
- Addition of Suggested Questions to be Addressed During the Post-Outbreak Debrief (Annex F)
