

## **Corrections for the 2000 Annual Summary of Reportable Diseases**

On page 3

- In the second paragraph, the second sentence should say “This increase is slightly more than the 11.8% increase in the previous year.”

On page 85

- The number of reports for hepatitis B undetermined for Vancouver is 8 and for Richmond is 5. Bringing the BC total of hepatitis B undetermined to be 231.
- The number of reports for hepatitis B chronic for Vancouver is 1118 and for Richmond is 390. Bringing the BC total of hepatitis B chronic to be 2510.

On page 86

- The rate per 100,000 for hepatitis B undetermined for Vancouver is 1.4 and for Richmond is 3.0. Bringing the BC rate of hepatitis B undetermined to be 5.7.
- The rate per 100,000 for hepatitis B chronic for Vancouver is 194.2 and for Richmond is 234.8. Bringing the BC rate of hepatitis B chronic to be 61.7.
